

Siegrist Announces Bond Commission Grant to Valley Shore Emergency Communications, Inc.

The Commission met on June 1 at the Capitol in Hartford to make a decision regarding the use of existing funds, including \$1,250,000 for VSECI for upgrades to the outdated emergency radio dispatch system that serve 11 towns. The approved funds will be used to interconnect member towns and allow coordination with adjoining systems.

“Investing in the safety of our community will protect the public while assisting the dedicated employees at VSECI who handle emergency call processing and dispatching needs,” said Rep. Siegrist, who thanked the Commission for their inclusion of Essex in their decision.
